CM No.12187/2012 (of the petitioners for directions)

1. By this application, the petitioners *inter alia* submit that the stay order granted by this Court be intimated by the respondent No.1 UOI to all the States across the country. We are conscious of the fact that stay order passed by this Court may not be binding on other State Governments. However, at the same time since respondent No.1 UOI is a party to the present proceedings and the Act is a Central Legislation, respondent No.1 UOI can at least inform all the States about the aforesaid orders. We order accordingly.

2. In view of the aforesaid order passed, Mr. Vikas Singh, Sr. Advocate appearing for the petitioners fairly states that if affiliates of the petitioners have filed any petitions in different High Courts, they will advise them to withdraw the petitions.

With the aforesaid directions, the CM is disposed of.
